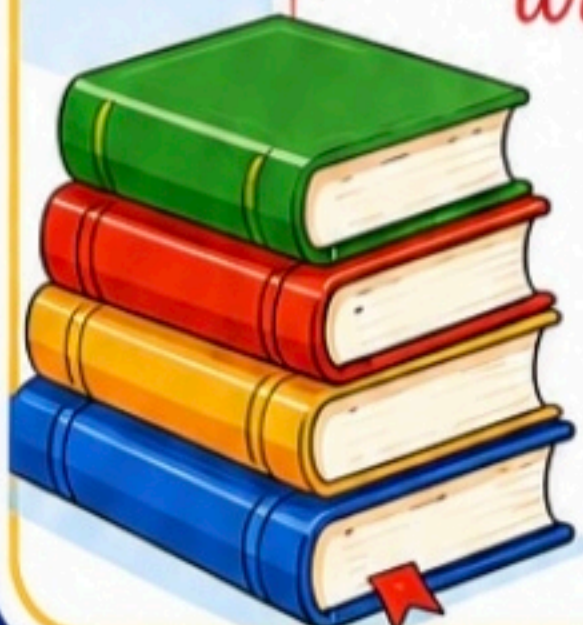
Dear Parents & students,

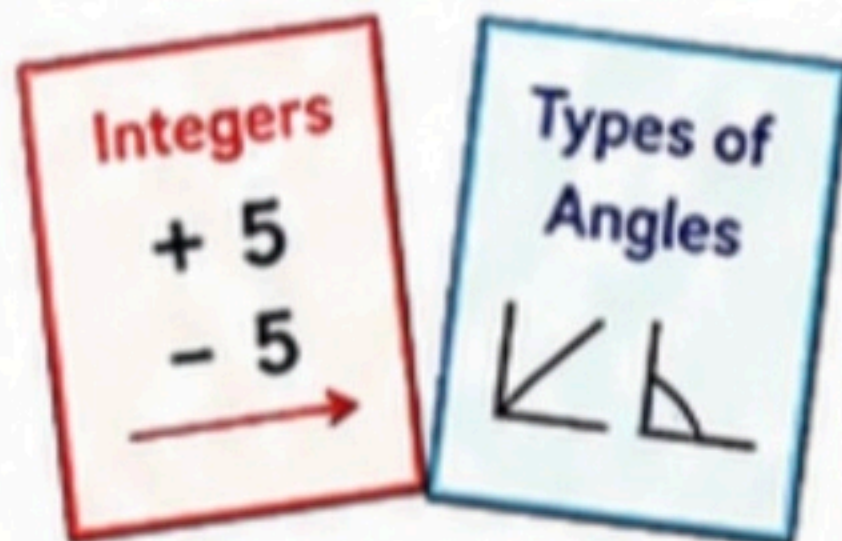

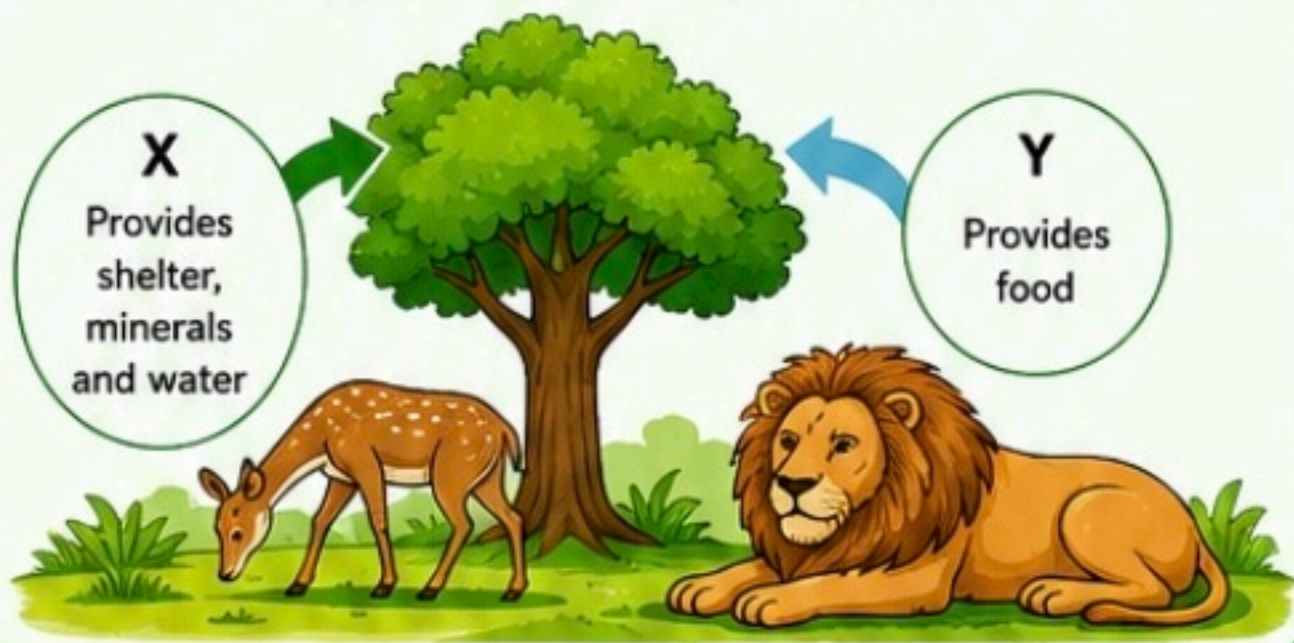

Dinner	Vegetable soup, roti, dal, green salad	Light and easy to digest
Before Sleep	A glass of warm milk	Good for bones, better sleep

Tips for a Healthy Life

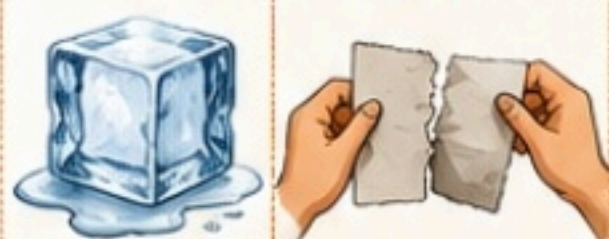
- ✓ Drink plenty of water.

Aspect	Jammu (Land Breeze)	Gujarat (Sand Breeze)
Type	Land Breeze	Sand Breeze (Hot dry wind)
Occurs	Night (land cools faster than water)	Daytime (hot wind from deserts)
Direction	From land to water	From land (desert areas) towards cooler regions
Effect on Temperature	Cool, pleasant air	Hot, increases temperature
Reason	Land cools quickly at night	Desert sand heats up quickly during day
Result	Lower temperature	Higher temperature

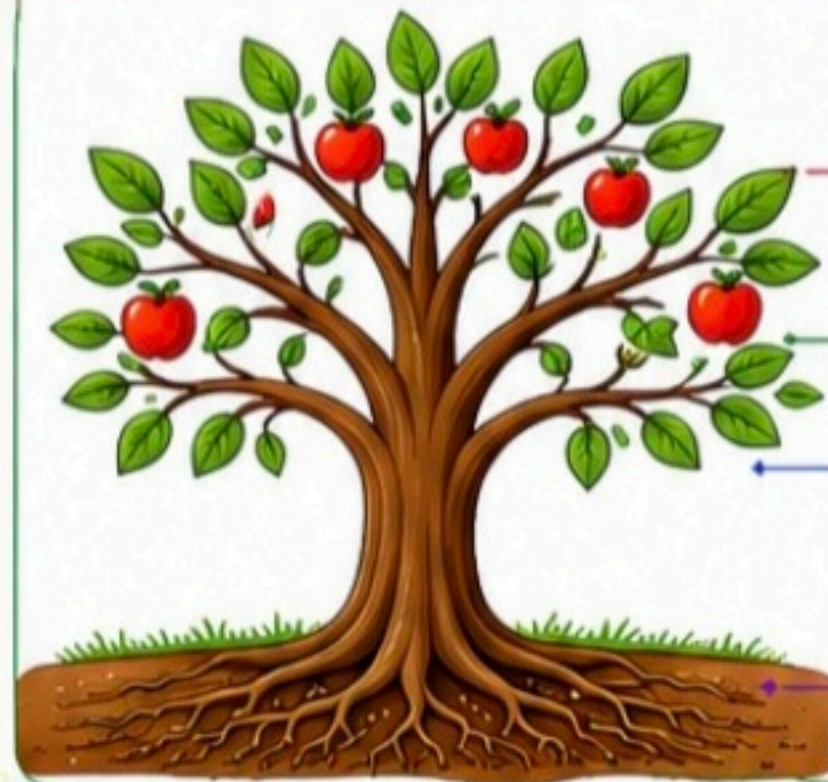

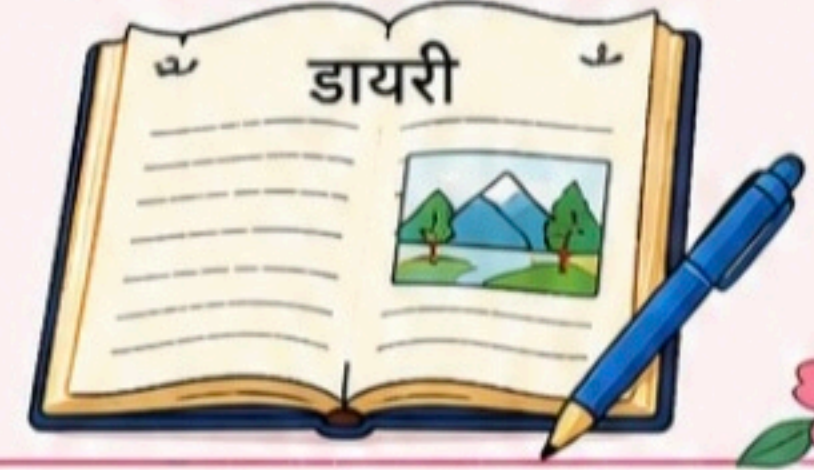
